Alexsandr Stravin was born in Anmauir, Krasnodar Region of Russia in 1960. He attended the Repin Institute of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture in St. Petersburg. He became interested in painting while studying the local architecture at university.

Although he painted everyday for many years he did riot begin to actively market his work until visiting Germany in the late 80's. There he met and worked with many other artists who were instrumental in bringing his work to prominence.

Stravin has developed the use of subtle color in a loose impressionist style while he maintained an uncanny attention to detail. This technique captivates and draws in the viewer.
